

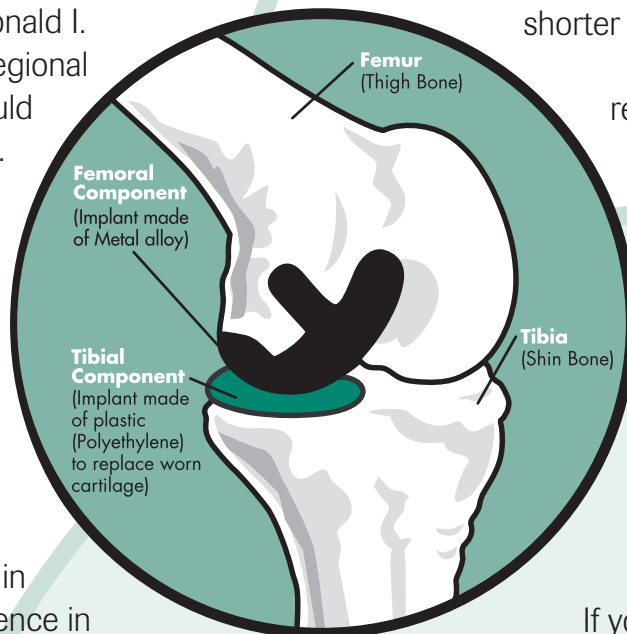
Here's news of a procedure that runs circles around conventional knee replacement surgery.
